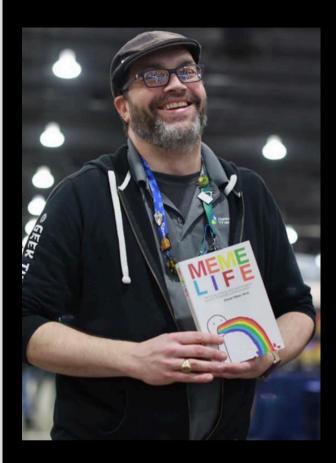
# SHANE TILTON



## DIGITAL SCHOLAR

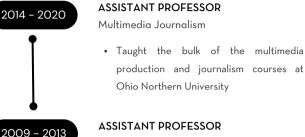
